The GVSU Baseball Program

The GVSU baseball program has established itself as one of the premiere programs in NCAA Division II. In 2006, GVSU was ranked as high as #3 in the country but the Lakers were upset in the regional championship game and ended the season with an impressive 47-10 record. GVSU has won four consecutive GLIAC conference championships. From 2003-05, the Lakers won three straight regional tournaments advancing to the NCAA Division II World Series in Montgomery Alabama with finishes of fourth in 2005, second in 2004, and fifth in 2003.



Camp Activities

GVSU baseball camps offer players an opportunity to learn skills necessary to become a more complete baseball player. The camp is an outstanding combination of instruction, competition and fun. Campers will learn skills such as hitting, base running, catching, pitching, outfield and infield play. There will also be fun games and prizes. The radar gun will be used too! Lunch and pool time are included. Baseball movies will be shown during lunch.

I understand that the camper will be subject to the rules and regulations of the GVSU sports camp. I understand that any person who repeatedly disobeys camp policies or procedures will be immediately expelled from camp. GVSU is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
